GOD'S LOVE IN MARRIAGE, FAMILY, AND CHURCH FAMILY

⁷ *Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.*

⁸ *Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.*

⁹ *This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.*

¹⁰ *This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.*

¹¹ *Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.*
(1 John 4:7-11 NIV)

I came across this passage recently and was struck by how many times the word, “love” shows up. Love is a major theme in the tiny book of 1 John. It is of course also a major theme throughout the pages of God’s word. This should not come as a surprise, for, as 1 John 4:8 says, “...God is love.”

If there were any question as to what that little phrase means, John explains it to us. God proved his love to us by sending his one and only Son (whom he loved), to die on the cross for us. It reminds me of our 2013 Annual Theme, which you may remember is “GOSPEL: GOD’S WORD FOR EVERYONE.” At the very heart of the Gospel is God’s love for all people. And it is in the light of such great love that we are called to love one another. Those of us who are married are called to love our spouses; all of us are called to love the members of our families; and all of us are called to love the members of our church family as well.


In that context, our February focus at First Baptist Church of Omaha will be “GOD’S LOVE IN MARRIAGE, FAMILY, AND CHURCH FAMILY.” God’s love, the sort of love that was demonstrated on the cross, is absolutely essential for healthy, Christ-honoring relationships in all of these settings—and it applies to each one of us.
