# Gospel: God's Word for Everyone

"We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all the saints—the faith and love that spring from the hope that is stored up for you in heaven and that you have already heard about in the word of truth, the gospel that has come to you. All over the world this gospel is bearing fruit and growing, just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and understood God's grace in all its truth. You learned it from Epaphras, our dear fellow servant, who is a faithful minister of Christ on our behalf, and who also told us of your love in the Spirit" (Colossians 1:3-8 NIV).

On October 22<sup>nd</sup>, I will be leaving Omaha for just under two weeks on a Mission Study Tour to Bolivia. Lord willing, I will be back in the pulpit on Sunday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Why am I going to Bolivia? This is a part of an endeavor sponsored by the American Baptist Churches of Nebraska, and also of the Rocky Mountain Region, along with International Ministries. The objective of the Study Tour is to give local US pastors handson, cross-cultural, and international experience at various locations throughout the world where ABC missionaries are at work. It is an honor, and a privilege to be invited to join this Mission Study Team!



But as I considered the words of the Apostle Paul from the beginning of his letter to the Colossians, I am also excited about this Study Tour for other reasons. Like Paul, I am praying for and thanking God for his Church, which is already present in Bolivia. Through our international partners, I have heard of their faith in Jesus Christ, about how the church is growing in their midst, and about exciting ways in which God is moving in their land. I am going in amazement of the fact that all over the world the gospel is bearing fruit. And like Paul was grateful for Epaphras, who had brought the gospel to the Colossians, I am grateful to our ABC missionaries, including folks like Mario Morales and JD and Rhonda Reed, who have been called by the Holy Spirit to share the gospel of Jesus Christ in places like Bolivia.

Additionally, so that you may know the purpose that will be guiding us as we go, the Study Tour team has agreed to the following statement:

The purpose of this short-term Mission Study Tour is: To develop relationships with our international partners and missionaries in Bolivia, To explore what God is doing in Bolivia through our international partners and missionaries, To seek ways to apply what we learn in our respective mission contexts, All while remaining open to the transformative power of the Holy Spirit.

As I go on this Study Tour, I am going with an open heart and an open mind, exciting to make connections with God's people and God's work in Bolivia. I also go with a desire to continue discerning the vision and mission God has for us back home at First Baptist Church Omaha. I would request your prayers for me and for the other members of the team as we head out, including those from Nebraska: Rev. Paul Marine (Benson Baptist Church, Omaha), Pastor Matt Wolf (Gibbon Baptist Church, Gibbon), Rev. Gordon Braun (First Baptist Church, Norfolk), and Rev. Robin Stoops (Executive Minister, ABC Nebraska).

May the gospel continue to bear fruit among us and throughout the world!
