Christmas Is Forever

From the Pastor's Desk

I don't know about you, but I am *excited* about Christmas at First Baptist Church this year! There is so much going on and so much to celebrate!

This Advent season, we will be taking a bit of a break from our regular series through the Gospel of Luke. Each Sunday we will be asking the question: "Who (or what) is Christmas <u>for</u>? Each Sunday we will look at God's Word to reveal part of the answer, culminating in our Candlelight Christmas Eve Services.

On December 1st, "CHRISTMAS IS FOR 'THE LEAST OF THESE." Looking at Jesus' teaching on children and the kingdom of God in Luke 18:9-17, we will seek to have a Christ-centered attitude as we enter the Advent season. We will also be presented with the challenge to serve "the least of these" as we learn about the important ministry of the Emanuel Foundation, which is an outreach ministry to street children in Cochabamba, Bolivia, who are at high risk for human trafficking.

On December 8th, "*CHRISTMAS IS FOR FAMILY*." Looking at the flight to Egypt in Matthew 2:13-15, we will consider what it really means to be a family both at Christmas and throughout the year, *especially* during tough times.

On December 15th, "CHRISTMAS IS FOREVER." In anticipation of the Community Feast and Cantata, also happening on this same date, we will look at the eternal implications of the Christmas story, as captured by the prophet in Isaiah 9:1-7. December 15th will be an amazing day of word, worship and service for our church family!

On December 22nd, "CHRISTMAS IS FOR THE WORLD." This message, based on Pslam 98, will encourage us to sing praises to God, who offers salvation to all nations, because of the manger and the cross. It will be part of a special joint service with American Karen Baptist Church, celebrating the international and cross-cultural aspects of Christmas. The service on this day will also feature a musical performance by the children of both congregations: A fitting tribute. The collaboration between our two congregations and our annual theme, "THE GOSPEL IS GOD'S WORD FOR EVERYONE!"

On December 24th, "CHRISTMAS IS FOR YOU." On Christmas Eve, we will reexamine the account of the shepherds and angels in Luke 2:8-20. This is where the rubber hits the road! In light of the birth of the Savior, YOU will be challenged to GO tell others about Jesus and GO serve "the least of these."

In the midst of all of this excitement, may you and yours also experience the grace and peace of our Savior, Jesus Christ.
